

California Group to Aid Returning Evacuees

The Friends of the American Way is cooperating with the WRA in adjusting the return of evacuees in Pasadena, Altadena and South Pasadena, according to Joe Carroll, relocation coordinator. Until the WRA is established locally, the committee is anxious to hear directly from the former residents of these towns, Carroll said.

The American Friends Service committee and the Federated Missions of Pasadena are planning to operate a hostel at the former Japanese Union church and a certain number of homes in the community will be open to evacuees until they can find permanent places of residence.

Advance notice of those returning should be given to the Friends of the American Way, 305 Kensington Place, Pasadena 3. For those going to towns other than Pasadena, Altadena and South Pasadena, reference should be made to the American Friends Service committee, Box 966, Pasadena 20.
