

Noted ACLU Attorney to Speak Here Saturday

A. L. Wirin, noted counsel for the American Civil Liberties Union, will speak at a mass meeting 2 p.m. Saturday in the high school auditorium. His talk will cover the following subjects: Endo and Korematsu cases, rescinding of the exclusion orders and California property escheat. Wirin is coming here at the invitation of the community council.

Aid Available for Obtaining Servicemen's Dependents Allowance

The WRA is interested in helping selectees obtain for their families the servicemen's dependents allowance if they are eligible. The selectees are asked to visit the Red Cross headquarters at 16-N to receive instructions in filing their application. These instructions are very important as the family's eligibility for the government allowance depends on the proper filling out of the application forms. If there is a delay in handling this matter, the family may not be able to fill out the application properly and this may mean that they will not receive the allowance when they are in need.

Reservists are especially urged to contact the local Red Cross before leaving for active duty and be assured that they have filled out the application forms and have collected the documents which they submitted with their application. This will safeguard their family's welfare.

Those who are eligible for class B benefits may become eligible for class B1 benefits upon resettling outside centers, and those who are ineligible in a center might, under circumstances, become eligible after leaving. Changes in the family composition of the dependents and significant changes in the amounts of expenses or income should be promptly reported to the Red Cross headquarters in the center or on the outside after leaving.
