

Urgent Call Issued for Typists, Stenographers, Hospital Help

According to the internal employment office, seven typists, three stenographers, and several bookkeepers, file clerks and clerks are urgently needed by various divisions, and the cooperation of qualified residents is requested. The hospital is in critical need of seven diet aide-waitresses and several kitchen helpers. Also as many nurse's aides as possible are wanted immediately. Otherwise, some of its services may be discontinued.

In order that the community enterprises may be able to pay its patronage dividends to the residents before the center closes, it is essential that its office force be augmented by five clerks to do this work. In addition, several sales clerks are badly needed by the department store and the canteen in block 20. Persons interested in working for the enterprises should contact its central office at once.
