

### Second Forum to Discuss Social Welfare Agencies

The second of a series of forums sponsored by the adult education department will be held 7:30 p.m. Wednesday in the north study hall of the high school building, Walter Schlosser, adult education director, announced. Topic of the meeting is "Services of the Social Welfare Agencies". Speakers will be Adolino Koll and Bots Choda of the social welfare department.

Among the questions planned for the meeting include: 1. Who is eligible to receive cash grants from public welfare agencies under the resettlement assistance program?, 2. How can a Heart Mountain family make application for resettlement assistance before leaving this center?, 3. If the head of a family who already has relocated lacks the money necessary to establish a home for his wife and children who are still in the center, what should he do to obtain resettlement assistance?, 4. What plans have been made for the resettlement of Heart Mountain residents who are chronic invalids or too old to work, and who have no funds to support themselves when they leave the center?

Establishment of a youth center will be discussed at a meeting 7:30 p.m. Sunday at the X lounge (23-25-N), according to Bill Teramoto, supervisor of clubs and organizations under the community activities department. Following the first meeting held Monday, Teramoto issued the following statement:

The general opinion of the gathering was in great favor of creation of such facilities, but since many of the blocks were not represented, the group thought advisable to call another meeting to plan and decide things in a democratic way."
