

First Special Coach to Leave Heart Mountain Tomorrow

The first special coach carrying passengers bound for California points will leave the Heart Mountain depot at 2 p.m. Wednesday. Final instruction issued by Claud C. Gilmore, relocation program officer, follow:

"Transportation requests should be obtained from the leaves office and tickets obtained from the ticket agent at the depot as early as possible. Baggage will be picked up Wednesday morning beginning at 8:30 a.m. If your baggage has not been picked up by 10 a.m., contact the leaves office to make sure it will be picked up immediately.

"All excess hand luggage must be checked on your railroad ticket. DO NOT FORGET THIS IMPORTANT DUTY. Otherwise baggage may be lost. Check it before noon if possible. Do not forget your ration books. Make sure the evacuee property officer understands how you want your freight and express handled.

"Food may be obtained on the dining car or at points where the train stops. There may be one train change necessary at Ogden, Utah. The train conductor will be in a position to furnish you information in this regard."

Traveling Regulations to Be Discussed at Forum Thursday

Among the questions planned for the meeting are 1. What differentiates a segregated, a parolee, an internec, an excluder or an alien? 2. Who is affected by travel restrictions? 3. What is the meaning of a blocked national?

Property Stored in Seattle Church in Unidentified State

Much of the property stored at the Buddhist church, 1427 Main Street, Seattle, is in an unidentified state, according to information received by Harvey Burnett, evacuee property officer. Some 400 families have property stored there.

Former residents of Seattle, who have property stored in the church, were asked by Burnett to contact his office so that they may identify their property from the list sent here. Reverend Murphy of Seattle assisted in preparing the list. He will be helpful in assisting with further identification of the property if his services are needed, Burnett said.

Two agricultural workers are needed by R. Ogata of Helena, Mont. Work consists of trucking and irrigating on a commercial garden farm. Ogata will pay all transportation charges. Persons interested are asked to contact the relocation office.

Work on the Glenwood Springs lumber deal will start around May 20, according to Jim Yamari, labor contractor in Denver. Persons interested should sign up with Eddie Yamaoka at the Sentinel office. Forty men are needed for logging work. A dollar an hour is guaranteed, although workers may work on a piece-work basis. Workers will be assessed \$1.50 to \$1.80 a day for board and room. Year around work is promised. Forty men will be needed later for work on the sawmill. Bozo Komatsu, former Heart Mountainee, will be foreman of this group. A good cook is needed, immediately. Wages will be \$45 a week with room and board.
