

### Second Group of Coaches Leaves 7:30 p.m. Monday

The second special coach movement bound for points east and west with approximately 205 residents aboard will leave the Heart Mountain depot at 7:30 p.m. Monday. There will be three coaches leaving for the west coast area, and one for points east. Of the west coast movement two coaches will go to Northern California, and one to Southern California.

The two special coaches leaving Heart Mountain June 4 for Northern California will arrive in Oakland at 10:15 a.m. June 7. According to Claud Gilmore, acting relocation program officer, they will probably be met by the relocation officers from Oakland and San Jose and by the relocation supervisor from San Francisco. The relocation supervisor has been asked to get in touch with Southern Pacific railroad officials in an attempt to arrange a better traveling schedule south from Oakland to San Jose and other points.

In any event those who are anxious to save a few hours may leave the special coaches at Oakland, crossing the bay by ferry and taking regular train service out of San Francisco arriving at San Jose at 1 p.m. June 7. Before this is done, however, it is suggested that everyone talk to the relocation officers who meet the train at Oakland to ascertain whether or not a better traveling arrangement has been provided.

Gilmore has been assured by the railroad officials that all tickets will be good for transportation to all points by either route.

### Plans Completed For Postponed Picnic

Plans for the postponed center-wide picnic which will be held Sunday, weather permitting, are being completed, according to Kaz Narita, publicity chairman.

The mess halls will again prepare the picnic lunches with the help of volunteers from each block. Breakfast will be served as usual.

### More Workers Needed at Tooele

Ninety families of Japanese ancestry are now working at the Tooele ordnance depot located 35 miles from Salt Lake City in Utah and find conditions there satisfactory.

Fine new housing is available at moderate costs. Furnished apartments with one-bedroom cost \$28 a month, with two-bedrooms \$32, with three bedrooms \$36. Bedding, dishes, and cooking utensils can be obtained at an additional dollar per month. Lights and water are free.

For a 48 hour week, earnings amount to about \$190 per month at the rate of 86 cents per hour. 5 percent is deducted for retirement, but can be recovered when you leave. As an example of the withholding tax, approximately \$7.20 per month would be deducted from \$190 for a worker who has three dependents.

Aliens and citizens can work if they are able bodied. Vacations with pay and sick leaves without loss of earnings are offered. Medical and recreational facilities are excellent at Tooele.

### Adult Education Classes To Close Today

All adult education classes except the auto mechanics and practical sewing project will close as of today, according to Walter C. Schoelssor, director of adult education. He also stated that the practical sewing project will close as soon as the present job production order is completed but the auto mechanic class will continue as long as interest is shown.
