

Special Train Will Leave 7:30 p.m. Friday

Special train No. 4 will leave Heart Mountain 7:30 p.m. Friday, July 6. Those who have indicated their desire to ride these special coaches will be transported to the depot on Wednesday and Thursday to obtain tickets, according to Claud C. Gilmore, assistant relocation program officer.

Ration books and travel grants should also be picked up on Wednesday and Thursday. Checkable baggage will be picked up on Friday, the day of departure. Those leaving are reminded to have their baggage ready when the truck calls. The one holding the tickets should accompany the baggage for checking. Check all baggage except personal items needed enroute, Gilmore said.

Workers Wanted for Glenwood Springs Lumber Deal

Sam Nishio, recruiter representing Jimmie Yanari of the Glenwood Springs Lumber deal is now here and will be at the outside employment office in 15-12-AB, 8:30 to 11:30 in the mornings and 1 to 5 in the afternoons until July 11.

LOGGERS are needed immediately, and the present scale is \$3.50 per thousand board feet, a rate where a man should be able to make 12 to 15 dollars per day after two weeks working 8 to 9 hours. During the first two weeks, however, workers will be guaranteed a dollar an hour.

SPECIAL HOUSING FOR FAMILIES: A forty apartment housing unit has been set up in Denver and will be allotted to families of those who come to work for Yanari. These apartments are two or three room units with adequate plumbing and is located near the heart of Nihonjin-machi. Although housing will not be ready for two months, anyone who signs up now will be allotted a unit. Yanari or Nishio will help in the actual relocation of the families.

HOUSING FOR THE WORKERS: The workers will be housed in CCC-type barracks, with single beds and mattresses furnished, but workers must supply their own bedding. Assessment for room and board will be \$1.50 per day and the meals are served in timber style, all you can eat. The cook was formerly employed as head-cook of Bennets restaurant in Denver, and the men who are working at the lumber project now are completely satisfied. CIGARETTES are plentiful also. Insurance is provided by the company, life and accident.

TWENTY MEN ARE NEEDED AS HORSE DRIVERS: No experience is required and older men and Isscis are preferred. They will be paid on the basis of piece work, 12 cents on a 16 feet log. A man working 8 to 9 hours a day should make a minimum of 12 dollars. However, a dollar an hour is guaranteed and the logs are dragged no further than a distance of 300 feet and will be mostly down-hill skidding.

SAWMILL WORKERS NEEDED: Minimum hourly rates set up by the War Labor Board are: 80 cents an hour for common laborers, 85 cents for offsetters, 90 cents for edgers and planers and \$1.10 an hour for sawyers. However, Yanari has set up a piece work plan, where the common laborers will make a dollar an hour, offsetters,

edgers and planers, \$1.25 an hour; and sawmen \$1.50 an hour. Yanari has contracts to keep all men employed by him working throughout the year at wages higher than average.

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation expenses will be paid by the company to anyone who are already out on indefinite leave. After the deal is completed (6 months) the company will also provide for transportation from the job site to any destination equivalent to the distance they first travelled to the job.
