

Next Special Movement Set For July 20

The special coaches which left last Friday evening were inspected by Joe Carroll and Claud C. Gilmore, of the relocation division, before they were loaded. They were found to be exceptionally clean and sanitary. All plumbing was in good working order and all cars were fully watered and iced. A cleaning crew was on hand to go over the cars but the only work that was necessary was dusting window sills.

The next special is set for Friday evening, July 20, according to Ulaud C. Gilmore, assistant relocation program officer. There will be special coaches to Northern California, to Southern California, and to the East. Idaho and Utah bound people will also have a special coach if there are sufficient numbers, otherwise, they will be allotted space on one of the California bound cars.

It is also planned to make special pullman car service a part of the July 20 train, Gilmore said. A request has been made to the railway company for two tourist sleeping cars, one to go to Northern California and one to Southern California. With the shortage of railway equipment in mind, the Washington WRA office has been asked to invoke necessary priorities to insure delivery of needed pullman cars.

These sleeping cars are being ordered primarily for those who are physically handicapped or otherwise unable to move without this service. Another reason is the extreme difficulty experienced in obtaining reservations on regular service. Those who are eligible to travel at WRA expense will be given first priority on sleeping car space, according to Gilmore. Those who are willing to pay extra fare to ride the pullman will be given secondary consideration, he said. It will probably be necessary to maintain an alternate list of prospects in order that space vacated by last minute cancellations may be filled, he said.

The following persons are eligible for sleeping car accommodations to be paid for by WRA upon certification of need by the Chief Medical Officer, according to Gilmore,

- Persons 65 years of age or older.
- Pregnancy after fourth month.
- Mothers with babies up to 18 months.
- Special medical cases.

Those interested in either the coaches or sleeping cars on July 20 should make all necessary preparation in the relocation division at once. Sleeping car space will be assigned on the basis of first come, first served, Gilmore said.

Servicemen's Dance and Baseball Game is Cancelled

Contrary to previous notice, the servicemen's dance scheduled for Thursday night at the gym has been cancelled, according to Yukiichi Nishiyori of the USO.
