Two Pullmans, Four Coaches to Leave 7:30 Friday Evening

The passenger list for the July 20 special train consists of approximately 225 persons the biggest portion of whom are returning to Southern California. This is the first time that Southern California have outnumbered those going to other points, according to Claud C. Gilmore, assistant relocation program officer..

The train is scheduled to leave Heart Mountain at 7:30 p.m., Friday evening. It will be made up of two pullman cars and four coaches. One pullman car will go to Southern California and one to Northern California. The passengers are aged, mothers with infants, and other persons who are physically handicapped. The railroad officials have said that in all probability the pullmans will travel with the coaches. There was a small amount of pullman space remaining available this morning, said Gilmore.

There are two coaches for Southern California, one to Northern California, and one for the east. This six car train will be the largest that has moved from Heart Mountain up to the present time. Reservations for this train should be made with the relocation division immediately, Gilmore added.

Future special coach movements are scheduled every second Friday henceforth and will be increased to every Friday when the need becomes apparent. Pullman cars will be scheduled as often as needed as long as they are available, said Gilmore.

The running schedule of Friday's train will be published in Thursday's bulletin.
