

Issuance of Special Train Gate Passes to be Discontinued

Because of confusion and delay caused by large crowds at the depot, and because of the possibility of accident as a result of switching cars, it has been decided that the issuance of gate passes to those who wish to bid farewell to friends riding on special trains will be discontinued, according to Claud C. Gilmore, assistant relocation program officer.

Henceforth, special trains will be loaded on the side-track in the warehouse area and only those relocating will be passed through the gates to board the train, he added.

The police will be used to control pedestrian traffic within the area and the Boy Scouts will again be called upon to assist persons with their hand luggage onto the train.

Trains are scheduled to leave Heart Mountain at 7:30 p.m. and this schedule will be maintained if possible. Occasionally however, it is not possible for the Burlington Railway to get the equipment spotted in time to load and leave on time. Taxis were not sent into the area to pick up passengers until the train is ready to load, said Gilmore. Residents relocating shouldn't be alarmed, therefore, if the taxi does not call to pick them up promptly at six o'clock. Very accurate lists of passengers are kept and they will not be left.

The taxi drivers have experienced some trouble in locating their passengers. In some cases, passengers have obtained other means of transportation to the depot. All passengers should stay at home until the taxis call. All other traffic will encounter difficulty in passing through the gate, Gilmore emphasized.

Silver Star Presentation Will be Held Tonight

The War department has awarded the Silver Star, the nations third highest decoration to Pfc. Fred Yamamoto posthumously. Pfc. Yamamoto, former Sentinel staff member was killed in action October 25, 1944 in France.

The medal will be presented to Mrs. Fumi Sato, 24-18-C, mother of Pfc. Yamamoto at a special ceremony to be held 8 p.m. tonight in the USO Y lounge.

The ceremony will be under the chairmanship of Bill Teramoto of Community activities. Vernon Ross of the Community Christian church will deliver the invocation and Reverend Jyokai Kow of the Buddhist church, the benediction. Lt. Justin Siegel of the local military police detachment will present the Silver Star and speeches will be given by Project Director Guy Robertson, representing the appointed personnel and Satoru Tsunoishi, president of the Servicemen's Family Club. This program is open only to members of the Servicemen's Family Club.
