250 Residents to Leave on June 4 Special Courses

It is expected that as many as 200 people will be leaving Heart Mountain for points east and west on Monday, June 4, the day of the next special coach mo-

vement, according to Claud C. Gilmore, relocation program officer. It would be practically impossable for the depot ticket agent, the leave office and the baggage

pickup truck to care for so many relocatees on the same day, Gilmore said.

Therefore, two special baggage trucks will be operated all day Thursday and Friday and until noon on Saturday, May 30, June 1 and 2, for the purpose of picking up checkable baggage. The drivers will have lists of those leaving on June 4 and will call for their baggage during working hours on one of those days. One member of the family, preferable the head, will accompany the truck and baggage first to the leave office for his transportation request and then to the depot to buy tickets and check the baggage. Have your checkable baggage ready when the truck arrives. Keep only your hand baggage at home to be taken to the depot with you on kenday, June 4:

Cush grants, ration books and gate slips must be picked up at the administration building on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Come early and avoid the rush.

We are negotiating with the railroad company to set the departure hour from Heart Mountain at approximately 5:30 p.m., which will allow everyone to have their evening moal in the moss halls. Exact departure hour from Heart Mountain and running schedules to all destinations will be published in the Sontinel Supplement of May 29.

In order to reduce the period required in shipping evacuee property to San Jose and Los angeles, it is our desire to ship the property in carload lots which should reach San Jose in 8 days and Los angeles in 10 days, Harvey Burnett announced. These leaving on the June 4 special car are urged to release their freight to the evacuee property officer on May 31, which will enable us to ship all freight in advance of departure. Consideration will be given to shipping a limited amount by express ever your checkable baggage allowance in order that your freight may be released by May 31, Burnett said.

CHECKABLE BAGGAGE -- approximately 150 pounds of clothing and personal effects which are checked with the depot ticket agent on your railroad ticket and are carreled on the same train with you in the baggage car to be delivered at depot of des-

tination to the owner upon presentation of baggage checks.

The following articles are among several which are too fragile or too valuable to be handled in checked baggage, and for which the railroad company cannot accept liability in case of loss or dawage; china, glass, or silverware; clocks or watches; firearms and ammunition; foodstuffs; fragile articles; fruit (cannod or fresh); jewelry; liquids of any kind; money; perishable articles; phonograph records; rudies; typewriters (pertable); valuable papers (bends, etc.); paper cartens weighing more than 50 pands. All beses should be reped.

HAND LUGGAD -- One or two small handy suttoness or bags containing tellet articles, and other personal items which must be carried in hand and kept in a convenient

accessible place for immediate use throughout the trip.
