 Hundred Men and a Girl" with

 "cartunes" and an educational  
 film on 'eyesight' completed the  
 program. It was an outdoor  
 affair, but the sound carried  
 very well. We took our folding  
 chairs so were quite comfortable  
 thro' out. There was a large  
 turn-out, and everyone enjoyed  
 himself very much. - Goodness,  
 it had been so long since I'd

attended Mass. Father Lavery wasn't  
 there; neither were the sisters, but  
 the visiting Father gave an impressive  
 sermon. He said the war is going  
 on because man forgot to love his  
 enemies - which I realized is <sup>q3</sup>  
 very, very true.

The past three days have been  
 extremely dusty. There are tractors  
 running about, scraping, dumping,  
 leveling the ground. So now the  
 earth, which was beginning to  
 pack, is chocolate-fine again.  
 I'd be willing to bet there is more  
 dirt in the air than there is on  
 the ground! Half the time my  
 hair is grey. - I'm just  
 dying to wash my hair, but there  
 is no water. We are having  
 another water-less day. Whenever
