PERMIT 7260

1. THE COMMANDING GENERAL, WESTERN DEFENSE COMMAND, AUTHORIZES THE PERSON ABOVE NAMED TO TRAVEL WITHIN SUCH PORTIONS OF MILITARY AREA NO 1 AND THE CALIFORNIA PORTION OF MILITARY AREA NO 2, WESTERN DEFENSE COMMAND, AS MAY BE NECESSARY IN TRAVELING BY THE MOST DIRECT COMMON CARRIER OR PUBLIC HIGHWAY ROUTE FROM RENO, NEVADA TO MANZANAR WAR RELOCATION CENTER, MANZANAR, CALIFORNIA UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
  - A. THE ROUTE TO BE FOLLOWED IS TO BE THAT WHICH INVOLVES THE MINIMUM TRAVEL DISTANCE WITHIN SAID MILITARY AREAS.
  - B. THERE SHALL BE NO STOPOVER ENROUTE, EXCEPT AT NAMED DESTINATION, WITHIN SAID MILITARY AREAS.
  - C. TRAVEL WITHIN SAID MILITARY AREAS SHALL BE PERFORMED BY COMMON CARRIER OR TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED BY WAR RELOCATION AUTHORITY.
  - D. TRAVEL WITHIN SAID MILITARY AREAS SHALL BE COMPLETED ON OR BEFORE 13 JULY 1944, AFTER SUCH DATE THIS PERMIT IS VOID.
  - E. AT ALL TIMES WHILE WITHIN SAID MILITARY AREAS PERMITTEE SHALL BE IN THE COMPANY OF THE OFFICIAL ESCORT DESIGNATED BY WAR RELOCATION AUTHORITY.
  - F. SPECIAL CONDITIONS: PERMIT EFFECTIVE 13 JUNE, 1944
2. IMMEDIATELY UPON COMPLETION OF TRAVEL HEREUNDER, PERMITTEE MUST RETURN THIS PERMIT TO COMMANDING GENERAL, WESTERN DEFENSE COMMAND, -ATTENTION: CIVIL AFFAIRS DIVISION-, PRESIDIO OF SAN FRANCISCO, CALIF.
3. THIS PERMIT BECOMES VOID IMMEDIATELY UPON ANY ATTEMPTED ALTERATION OR COPYING.
4. ANY TRAVEL PERFORMED CONTRARY TO THE EXPRESS PROVISIONS OF THIS PERMIT WILL CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF PUBLIC PROCLAMATIONS NOS 6, 7, 8, AND 11, HEADQUARTERS, WESTERN DEFENSE COMMAND, DATED JUNE 2, 1942, JUNE 8, 1942, JUNE 27, 1942, AND AUGUST 18, 1942, RESPECTIVELY, AND WILL SUBJECT PERMITTEE TO ARREST AND PROSECUTION UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PUBLIC LAW NO 503, 77TH CONGRESS, AN ACT ENTITLED "TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF RESTRICTIONS OR ORDERS WITH RESPECT TO PERSONS ENTERING, REMAINING IN, LEAVING, OR COMMITTING ANY ACT IN MILITARY AREAS OR ZONES."
