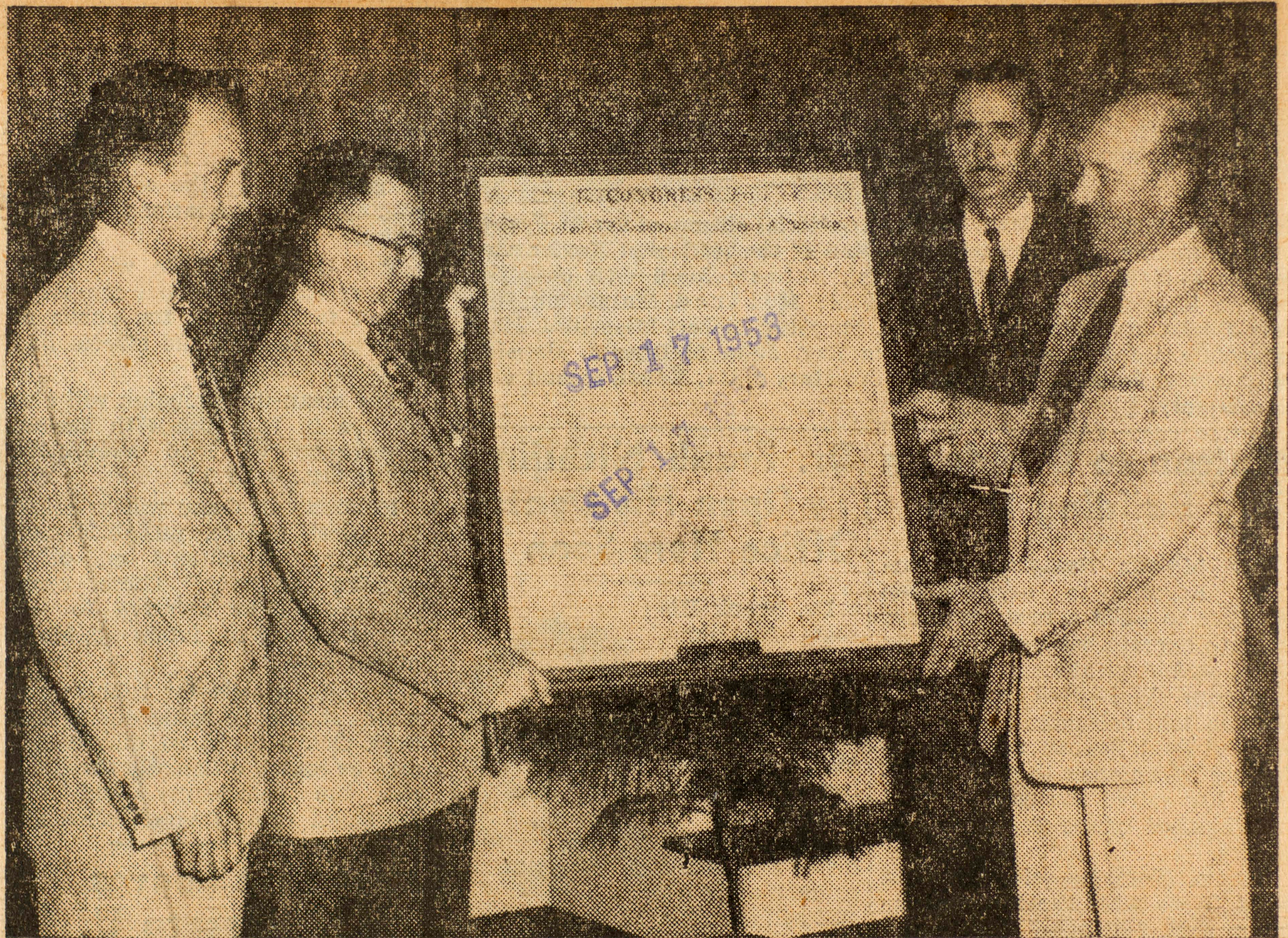

## Matson to Decide on Ship Building Soon

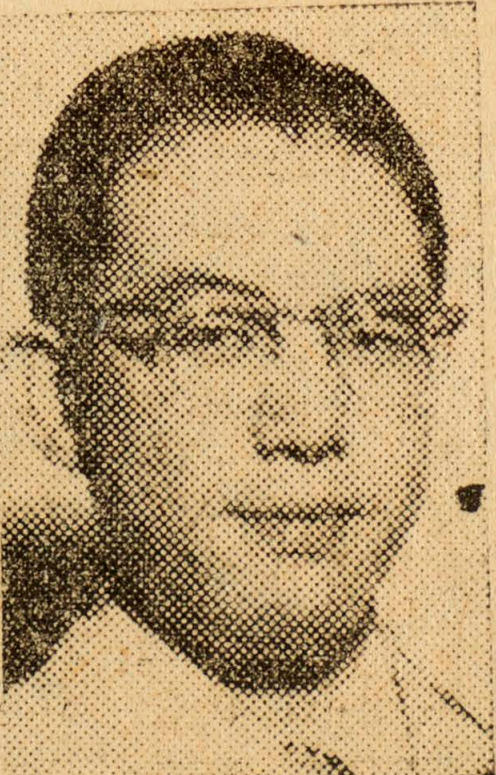
The Matson Navigation Company expects to decide soon whether to build a new passenger liner to operate between the West Coast and Australia.

Matson Vice-president George Hansen told delegates to the Hawaii Visitors Bureau carrier conference Wednesday that the company has solved the problem that has blocked plans for the new service.

The problem, he said, has been what to do with the liners Monterey and Mariposa. The Monterey now has been sold to the United States government and sale of the Mariposa is being negotiated with an Italian steamship line.
