A federal investigative report dated 15 December 1939 states that subject's father, Kenden YABE, was the author of editorials which appeared in the Yoen Jiho, a Japanese newspaper published in Koloa, Kauai, T.H. and later at Hanapepe, Kauai, T.H. The Yoen Jiho discontinued publication at the outbreak of the war, and its President-Manager, Chinyei KINJO, was interned. This newspaper was reported to have pro-Communist tendencies.
