The undersigned citizens and residents of White Salmon, Washington and of the White Salmon valley, and being friends and neighbors of George Kida, Kay Kida and Kensilo Kida, residents of the White Salmon valley, living seven miles from White Salmon, do hereby testify to our belief that these people are actually loyal to America and the American viewpoint, and have always conducted themselves as good neighbors, loyal citizens and taken a part in the community. They have lived here for more than 28 years, farming approximately 700 acres of land, with from 150 to 160 head of livestock and conducting a stock and dairy farm.

That we feel entirely sure that if they can be left upon their present farm, no harm will result; that we who own property in the same vicinity feel entirely safe to have them living there, respectfully request any officials having anything to do with the pending evacuation of persons of Japanese racial descent, to make every effort to have an exception made of these people.
