

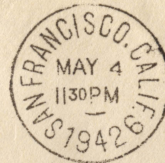


Dear Madam:
