to let you know I still am
thinking of you, and only
wish we could see each other
but hope we will meet before
too long. I sure get lonesome
for you all. havent seen all
for several days, expect he is
very buisy in the Hay. This is
the first Real Summer day we
have had. he was here one
day last week he said he had
all of his Hay down. but
had not began cutting ours, as
the ground was so wet, but I
expect he has a lot of it down now
I never seen such a late Spring
here. vickie went down town
with Ethel this afternoon to
see the Dr. her Blood is not as
good as it should be. and he has
to keep watch of it. I am gaining
quite a bit but try and do not
overdo havent been any place

yet, we do not have much
company, for which I am
Thankful for. Kay have
George write me about your
Bedding, did you take any
with you? I am anxious to
know if you are comfortable
or not we have put up some
Straw Berries, or Vickie has,
I can hardly see the season
go by and not do something
about Fruit but if this war hangs
on like it looks now we won't
be home any way. Say George just
how does things look to you
Folks: there, Vida just what do
you ~~think~~ think of the situation
and are you getting rested up
and Kay dont do too much and
get too badly run down, and dont
get too badly discouraged for this
won't last always, and we all
want to meet again. my next
old age Pension check will be
\$40.00 I will send you some of
it expect I should give Vickie
20 or 25.00 dollars. This time well
I dont know any news, so will
have to stop. with lots of Love to
you all and hope to see you all
