war is over I dont suppose.
I do wish they would get it over with
it is going to be hard on us a neighbor
Mr Johnson lives on the place while
they are gone. I am not well and Kay is such
a good nurse I sure miss her. if things
dont look better I dont know how I will
come out I tell you things look pretty serious
these days. how does things look with you.
Kay is so mad at the Japs they are responsible
for all this trouble and I hope they get their
pay. Say is any of Marks children left. I had
a letter from Nellie Jassen not long ago -

are you living in Town, I hope you Folks
can get to see us if we can only hold out
A while longer, tell me about your children
I do hope I can live to see you Folks
again. where is Kates Family, and is any
of the Family single Charlie where does
Sams live now, well, well I guess
I must stop as it is bedtime
and write when you can
