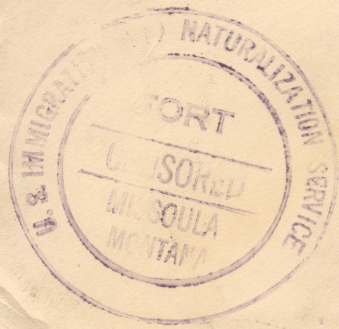

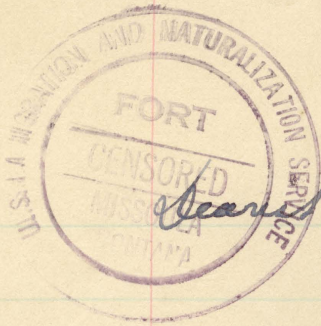

I am glad to know you got our picture, but you did not mention about my Japanese letter; did you get it?

The deal with Patterson Co. is not yet closed, so Aunt Eva and I are going to see Mr. Hampton and make final deal with the Co. before we evacuate.

Do not worry about our evacuation, the government will have the full ~~charge~~ charge and if we do our part, the government will do all it can to help us. We are very grateful that so far nothing happened, had warm house to live in, plenty of food, and soft beds to sleep in, "surely, the goodness and mercy shall follow ^{us} all the days of our lives, and we shall dwell in the house of the Lord for ever."
