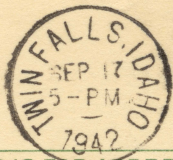

We live in the next block to her so we can see her quite often. I see her especially often because a good friend of mine lives right next door to her, so I can make two visits in one.

Eva didn't seem to like your calling her "fat Eva". She's thinner now, but she still thinks as much of food as ever. To very time she tells Roy she says, "Got anything good to eat?" Roy always teases her about that.

Krys insists on our calling her "minim" now; she's as long legged and active as ever, only taller and not so thin.
