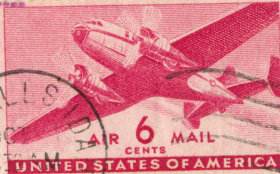
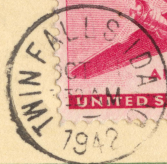

Dearest Kii: - your Birthday comes on Oct. 7, and although we cannot send you anything or cook you a birthday dinner, our love is with you just as much; we wish you a very happy birthday & and, <sup>are</sup> hoping that by next birthday we could all be together, - we wish and hope for that all the time. You will be 45 yrs old, wouldn't you? Well, life ~~star~~ begins at 40, so keep your chin up and be of good courage.

I am beginning to get used to the climate here and I am feeling better now than I did when I first came here. Dry climate is better for me than damp one, and although we have lots of dust, it is not going to be that way all the time, they are irrigating the area now, so soon the dust will be settled.

yesterday we got our stove put in, it is a funny looking one, sort of pot-belly shaped one for coal. We are waiting for the coal now.
