to you. His picture was taken in
front of that Baptist church near Sato's home.
Roy went there on his furlough before he
went to camp Shelby, Miss.

Roy liked you very much, he always
used to say that Sac. Kie was the only ^{one} ~~is~~
^{Roy knows} who could understand Nisei so well because
Kie went to American schools.

Well, Mrs. Sato, his father is studying
English very hard, has been doing that ever
since evacuation - and now he is corresponding
with his boys in the Army in English.
Mrs. Sato is doing it really well.

Tonight I was invited to Tavis for a
Portland M. C. church get together but after all
day's work I don't feel like going, besides
my ear begins to bother me as evening
when I get tired. I was resting after I came
home but thought to write these few lines and
go to bed with hot water bottle on my ear that
always helped me so far.

I believe Sumner is leaving our
Minidoka, for the mornings getting quiet

chilly. The day before yesterday I had to
keep some fire in the stove all day, but
today in the afternoon it got so hot outside
and fire stice kept on burning in the stove
that the room got hot like monkey cage,
a small lump of coal burn so well and
long.

Milton & Molly Maeda went to Wisconsin
for a good job; they left this morning.
Now Maeda are only Pa & Ma left in
the center, all the children gone outside.
Min. Yarin went along with them fast way,
I believe he is going to see his dad at
N. M.

A boy of 2 1/2 years old got drowned in
the canal near by five days ago but today
searchers found him. His mother, people say is
sick from worry.

I wonder if you are still getting your
Irrigator? Get me know.

The "Beef Tea" cube you sent is good, espe-
pecially on chilly evenings. The yeast tablets
you sent are about half gone, we are all taking
them. But please don't spend money any more
because you need some money on the train
when you get to come home. Some people tell
me that when delays, you have to pay that extra
for the meals and lodging so you must keep
some. Did you have your hearing yet?
Yesterday I went to dentist's got one cavity filled, a
Dr. Scott did the work, an old dentist but very careful.
