Enclosed please find four copies of the "Personal History Statement" sent to us by Dr. Norman W. Brown of the University of Pennsylvania. Two copies are to be filled out by Mr. Fujii and two copies by Mrs. Fujii. They are to be returned at once to the WRA office in Philadelphia. Upon receipt of your March 13th letter, we took up the matter of Mrs. Fujii's additional employment at the University of Pennsylvania. If both meet the requirements, they would be willing to employ both.

We note that Mr. Fujii was worried because the work at the University of Pennsylvania might be of short duration. We believe that this might be to his advantage. We have heard many fine comments about his outstanding business ability, and the summary shows that he has been an owner and manager of a bottling company for 11 years. The job at the University of Pennsylvania paying \$200 a month, if he is accepted, would give him a chance to look around with a view to either establishing his own business here or in obtaining proper employment with one of the outstanding Philadelphia bottling companies.
